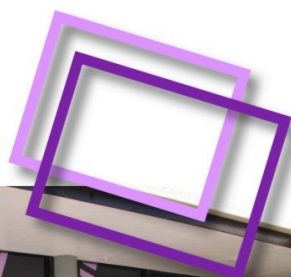

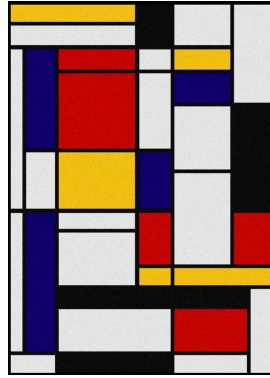
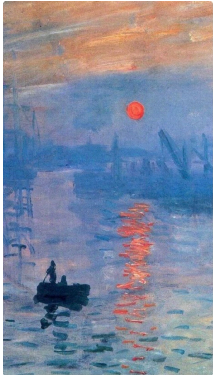

ABSTRACTIONS in JUNE

The topic of 'Abstraction' often brings to mind very non-representational works like those done by Kandinsky, Rothko or Turner. However, abstractions are defined as 'a deviation from the norm' and come in a range from mild (Impressionism) to more extreme (Non-representational Abstracts).

- CONTRAST is VITAL: 1. Value - Light Vs Dark 2. Colour - Intensity, Opposites (Complementary) 3. Edges - Harder Vs Softer
- COMPOSITION GUIDES can be the starting point for your artwork as they GIVE STRUCTURE & HELP DIRECT THE VIEWER'S EYE?
- WHICH ART PRINCIPLES or ELEMENTS will you use to GIVE FOCUS to your CENTRE of INTEREST?
- ABSTRACT WORKS use LAYERING, MARK-MAKING & BOLD/ SUBTLE COLOUR to PULL SECTIONS FORWARD or PUSH THEM BACK.
- ADDING PAINT / MIXED MEDIA or REMOVING / COVERING parts of them can improve your artwork - Experiment!

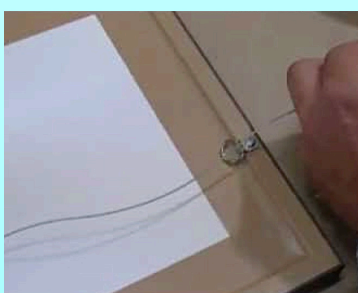
ARTWORKS READY FOR SALE = SEALED with TAPE + "D" Hooks + WIRE



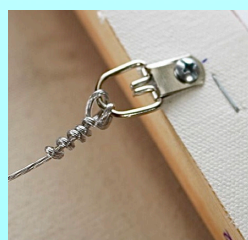
Use **D-RINGS** big enough to hold your artwork's weight

Secure quality **TAPE** to seal the gap between frame & back



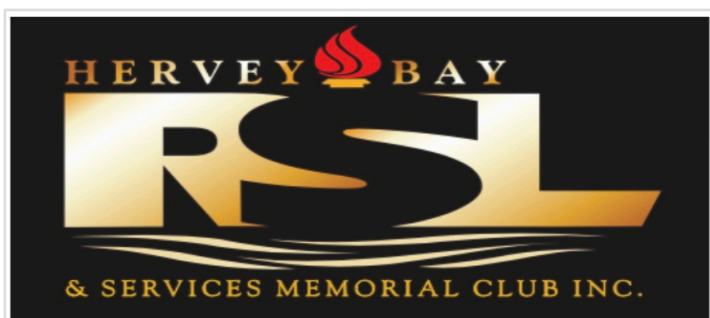
D-Rings must fit various sized hooks

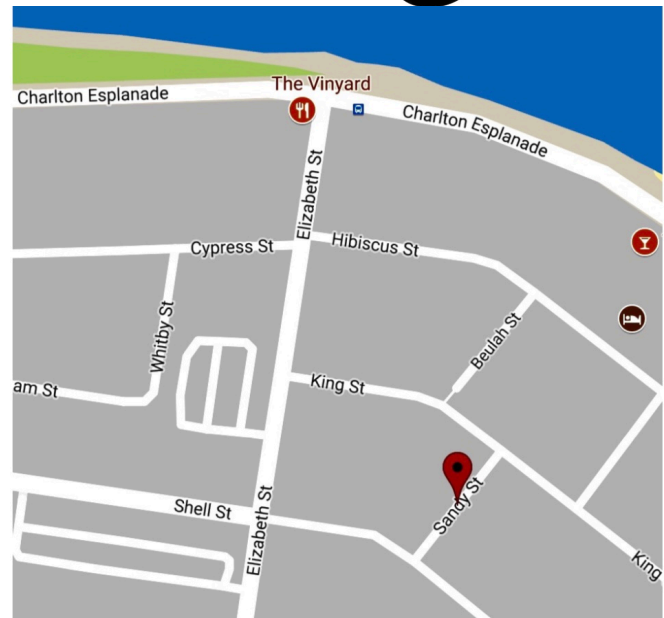
