

Oil Painting Workshop with Ben Winspear



**OVERVIEW**: Ben Winspear is a Victorian based painter and teacher of Art. Ben brings a wealth of knowledge, and experience and has won many awards including the 2016 AME Bale Travelling Scholarship - and is a passionate Plein air painter. Using traditional oil painting techniques and skills Ben brings his unique approach to creating impressions of the Australian landscape. Ben draws his inspiration from the early Australian Impressionist movement combined with the beauty of the nature surrounding us.

**AIM:** Exploring the fundamental aspects of tone, form, colour and edge and simplifying the oil painting process. Demonstrating step by step, his unique colour mixing to replicate the true colours of the Australian bush. <u>Basic Colour Palette</u>: Burnt Sienna, Yellow Ochre, Cobalt Blue, Ivory Black & Titanium White. (List of optional Mid and Extensive colour palettes are listed on the website).

Painting Medium: Number 1

Hogs hair bristle brushes – variety of flats, filberts, rounds, and a fan, rigger or script brush

Flat palette, willow stick charcoal, masking tape, rags, water container, apron,
